GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

The Environmental Educator supports program implementation for students ranging in age from toddlers to senior citizens, focusing on the ecology and natural history of the Chesapeake Bay. The Environmental Educator will play a lead role in caring for the equipment and marine life in the Holt Center's Wet Lab, including tank maintenance, weekly feedings, and general animal handling.

The Environmental Educator will work closely with the Director of Science Programs to deliver instruction in a wide variety of programming formats including:

- Land-based ecology programs for school groups in the spring, fall, and winter at the Foundation's Holt Education Center, a state-of-the-art facility located in the heart of Chestertown's National Landmark Historic District
- Land-based ecology programs for school groups in the spring and fall at the Foundation's Lawrence Wetlands Preserve, an 8.5-acre urban nature center featuring a variety of ecosystems including upland forest, swamp, marsh, shrublands, meadows, and a freshwater pond
- Classroom-based instruction in area schools focusing on how land use in local watersheds impacts the health of aquatic ecosystems downstream
- Week-long summer camps for young children
- Academic enrichment programs for infants and toddlers
- Walking tours of historic Chestertown with area schools
- Canoe and kayak day trips on tidal tributaries in the region
